Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and there is no legal impediment to their marriage. They have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondent Nos.4 to 6, who are the family members of petitioner No.1.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

During the course of arguments, marriage certificate has been filed in the Court and the same is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of

marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Bhogpur, District Jalandhar, Punjab, to consider and decide the representation dated 26.09.2015 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners and provide necessary protection to them, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6, in accordance with law.
