The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.42 dated 23.03.2010 under Sections 406, 498-A and 420 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC) registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

On instructions from ASI Labh Singh, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner in compliance of order of this Court dated 26.02.2015 has joined the investigation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 26.02.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper

with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave the country without permission of the Court.
