Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.274 dated 30.08.2014, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 40, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

Prosecution story in brief is that in July, 2012, accused met the complainant and assured him that he would get his son Anil posted in Indian Railways on the post of Ticket Collector. Anil, Manjit, Neeraj and complainant paid ₹9,00,000/- to the accused for providing jobs to Anil, Manjit and Neeraj. Forged letters were issued by the accused to Anil, Manjit and Neeraj asking them to appear in the examination, which was to be conducted at Calcutta on 09.12.2012. Thereafter, fake letters were issued in the names of Anil, Manjit and Neeraj asking them to attend training and thereafter, letter dated 01.02.2013 was sent to them that the training programme had been cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely involved in this case. In fact, petitioner himself was a victim. Petitioner is ready to join investigation.

In the present case, allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. As per the prosecution case, petitioner and his co-accused took ₹9,00,000/- for providing jobs to Anil, Manjit and Neeraj. The said applicants were also issued forged letters asking them to appear in examination and to participate in the training programme. Later fake letters were issued to them that the training programme had been cancelled. Petitioner might be required for custodial interrogation.

Dismissed.
