LISA GILL, J.

This petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7 as the petitioners have contracted marriage against their wishes.

On issuance of notice of motion, reply had been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 wherein it is observed that statements of all the private respondents had been recorded. They have stated that they have no objection to the marriage contracted between the petitioners and they will not interfere in their lives.

On 26.11.2014, it had been submitted that the petitioners still face threat from respondents No. 6 and 7 namely Tejpal and Ranjit Singh. Time had been sought to file requisite affidavit in this respect. On 17.12.2014, some more time had been sought by the learned counsel for the petitioners for filing the said affidavit. No such affidavit has been filed till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has since been resolved and the petitioners no longer face any threat at the present point of time from the said respondents. In view of the same, this petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, prays that liberty be afforded to the petitioners to approach respondent No. 2 in case threat to their life and liberty is revived on the basis of averments in this petition.

The present petition, is disposed of accordingly with liberty as aforesaid.
