Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.238 dated 22.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Civil Lines, Kaithal, District Kaithal (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations lodged by the complainant-Dharambir, he had purchased a Tata Trola from Amarjit Singh vide affidavit dated 13.6.2013 and on payment of Rs.3,50,000/- out of total sale consideration of Rs.9,75,000/-, he had received the possession of the said Trola. On the day of occurrence, his parked Trola was taken away by the said Amarjit Singh along with other co-accused including the petitioner.

It was contended that the petitioner/accused is the recorded owner of the said Trola and as such no offence is made out against the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that after the grant of interim protection by this Court, vide order dated 19.10.2015, the petitioner/accused has since joined the investigations.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by S.I. Ramesh Chander, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 19.10.2015, is made absolute.
