As per allegations of the prosecution, both the petitioners fired with an intention to kill.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the fire has not hit anybody.

I have heard the said submission but do not find any force in the same.

It is not the requirement of law that the fire must hit. The weapon of offence is yet to be recovered.

So, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made out.
