1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.197, dated 30.08.2014, Sections 411, 414, IPC, Section 25 of Arms Act, Sections 21 and 22 of NDPS Act, Section 14 of Foreigners Act and Sections 3, 34, 20 of the Indian Passport Act, registered at Police Station Gharinda, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 19.02.2015, this Court has admitted the petitioner on ad-interim bail subject to his furnishing bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lac only) with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. Petitioner was further directed to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Shamsher Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and all the recoveries have been effected from him and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Accordingly, the order dated 19.02.2015 passed by this Court granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to abide all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of, accordingly.
