By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.62, dated 28.02.2015, registered under Sections 307, 380, 447, 511, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station Division No.5 Civil Lines Ludhiana, District Ludhiana City.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 31.10.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for

custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 31.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
