The petitioner and his late wife while traveling on his motorcycle on 10.08.2010 at around 7:40 AM are stated to have met with an accident with a Esteem Car, being driven by respondent No.4-Jaspreet s/o Baldev Singh. An FIR No.111 dated 10.08.2010 was lodged with Police Station Sadar, Sangrur (**Annexure P-1**) by a passerby, namely, Varinder Kumar. In the said accident, the wife of the petitioner had died while petitioner sustained serious injuries.

Upon investigation, a Cancellation Report was submitted and on account of the protest petition filed by the present injured petitioner, the Magistrate has proceeded the case as a complaint case against the said Jaspreet (respondent No.4).

The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed with the allegations that upon such a recourse, Jaspreet/respondent No.4 is time and

again threatening the present petitioner, who is employed as Lecturer in the Lovely Professional University, Phagwara, with serious consequences in case such a complaint is not withdrawn, therefore, a direction is sought to be issued to the SSP, Sangrur to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation/complaint dated 25.09.2015 to SSP, Sangrur (**P-3**) already stands filed by his client, who is satisfied if a direction is issued to the said Officer to look into the same. The prayer is reasonable and, therefore, liable to be accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the S.S.P., Sangrur to look into the representation (**P-3**) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
