Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.99 dated 16.9.2014 registered under Sections 307, 326, 323, 324, 341, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar.

Notice of motion was issued and petitioner was directed to surrender before the learned trial Court, which shall admit the petitioner on interim anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.10.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner surrendered before the learned trial Court and his bail bonds were accepted vide order dated 26.10.2015.

The above-said facts have gone unrebutted on behalf of the learned counsel for the State and rightly so, it being a matter of record.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 19.10.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
