SNEH PRASHAR, J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 42 dated 02.03.2014, under Sections 15, 61 and 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station, Passiana, District Patiala.

2. Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

3. As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner-accused Gurbinder Singh @ Babbu was found in possession of 7 Kg of Poppy husk and 1100 intoxicant tablets of 79 mg each. Report of the CFSL shows that ingredients of diphenoxylate hydrochloride were found in the said tablets. The recovery of such contraband from the possession of the petitioner-accused falls under the commercial quantity. Trial is

stated to be in progress.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail and the instant petition is hereby dismissed.

However, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
