Ram Gopal alias Gopal has filed this petition under the provisions of Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 246 dated 24.05.2013 under Sections 420, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bhiwani

Relevant facts of the case, that Manjeet Singh was accused in a case arising out of FIR No. 48 dated 28.3.2013 under Sections 393 and 394 IPC registered at Police Station GRP Hisar. One Luxmi submitted forged school leaving certificate [Annexure P/2] during judicial proceedings. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhiwani noticed the forgery and reported the matter to the police. Luxmi was arrested during investigation and later on, it was revealed that the forged certificate was obtained with the help of Ajit for consideration of Rs.16,000/-. During interrogation of Ajit, it was revealed that present petitioner, Ram Gopal @ Gopal was instrumental in the preparation of the said forged school leaving certificate.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he is not involved in this case in any way. He is ready to join the investigation. So, he be released on anticipatory bail.

Having considered the above facts, this Court is of the considered view that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required as the allegations against the petitioner are of serious nature involving forgery of document and using the same in judicial proceedings. So, the present petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail. The petition stands dismissed *in limine*.
