Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.202 dated 13.09.2012, under Sections 295-A IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Parminderjit Kaur alleging that the petitioner had used harsh words against the complainant besides abusing the husband of lady punch in the name of their caste.

Statements of the parties have been recorded by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jagraon. A report has been submitted to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

In view of the matter having been compromised, following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that the petitioner will deposit a total sum of Rs.10,000/- in the shape of bank draft in the name of the complainant with the Registry in lieu of unnecessary harassment caused to the complainant. It will be open to the complainant to get amount released by moving an application.
