The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the impugned order dated 10.06.2014 (**Annexure P-8**), passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Abohar, wherein inquiry report dated 22.10.2007 of Senior Superintendent of Police, Muktsar (**Annexure P-3**), showing the petitioners as innocent, has not been considered, as consequence also the order dated 21.11.2008 (**Annexure P-5**), passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Abohar and the order dated 08.05.2009 (**Annexure P-6**), passed by learned Sessions Judge, Ferozepur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has become infructuous on the ground that the petitioners have been acquitted by the learned trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
