The petitioner through the instant petition under Section 482 seeks direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to protect his life and liberty claiming that at the instance of private respondents, he was taken to police station.

Reliance has been placed on photographs indicating that the petitioner is walking ahead of four police officials in a lane.

In reply filed, the application has been resisted by respondents stating that the allegation mentioned in the application are false and baseless and it is open to the petitioner to approach the police authorities if he has got any apprehension.

I have taken into consideration the circumstances of the case and I am of the opinion that the petitioner has got a civil litigation with the private respondents. He has filed a suit for declaration that he is owner in possession of property mentioned in heading of the plaint.

After going through the facts and circumstances of the case I do not think appropriate to issue any direction for protection of life and liberty as there does not appear to be any cause to file the petition. However, in the interest of justice, it is ordered that in case the petitioner has got any apprehension at the hands of police of Moga, it is open to him to submit a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga. In case the petitioner is not required as an accused in any case, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga will look into the grievance of the petitioner and would direct the issuance of a notice under Section 160 CrPC.

With the above observations this petition is disposed of.
