Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.51 dated 23.6.2013 registered under Sections 18/25/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Kheri Gandian, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court. He was on regular bail. But on one date of hearing, i.e. 10.8.2015, petitioner could not appear because of bona fide reasons, which were beyond his control. He further submits that petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today and learned trial Court may be directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner, on the basis of totality of facts and circumstances of the case, brought to the notice of the learned trial Court, at the instance of the petitioner.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today. The learned trial Court shall consider the bail application of the petitioner, keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, brought to its notice, at the instance of the petitioner, by passing an appropriate order, strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of, accordingly.
