The present petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners as they have solemnized marriage contrary to the wishes of private respondents and are apprehending threat at their instance.

Petitioners, in person, are present in the Court.

Admittedly, petitioner No.2 has not attained the age of majority i.e 21 years. The prayer of the petitioners is only for protection as they are being given threat by the private respondents. The petitioners have also moved a representation, which is annexed as Annexure P-5 with the petition but no action has been taken thereupon by respondent No.2 so far.

Without commenting anything on the validity of marriage and keeping in view the averments made in the petition, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider the representation moved by the petitioners and pass necessary orders in accordance with law after hearing both the parties. However, in case, any threat is there to the petitioners, the necessary action be taken by respondent No.2 in this regard.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
