Learned counsel for petitioner has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioner to take up all the pleas available to her before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on the date fixed i.e. 29.10.2015, her personal appearance thereafter shall remain exempted before the trial Court during trial subject to the following conditions:-

- i. Petitioner shall be represented through counsel;
- ii. shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii. shall not dispute her identity as accused;
- iv. shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence but in the presence of her counsel;
- v. shall appear before the Trial Court as and when required by the Trial Court;
- vi. any other condition which the learned Trial Court may impose.
