HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.26 dated 4.3.2015 under Sections 420, 415, 417, 419, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot qua the petitioners, namely, Suresh Kumar son of Kishan Chand and Rattan Chand son of Kathu Ram.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that bare perusal of the contents of the FIR shows that the matter in dispute is altogether civil in nature and, therefore, the petitioners cannot be proceeded against on the basis of the said F.I.R.

To a specific query to learned counsel for the petitioners

regarding stage in the FIR, he stated that the police is investigating the matter.

Considering the fact that the FIR in question is at the initial stage and the matter is under investigation, this Court does not find any merit in the case to interfere at this stage. Once it is noticed that the FIR in question is under investigation and the police is yet to complete the investigation, it is premature to interfere with the FIR and to quash the proceedings.

Accordingly, I find no merit in the present petition and the same is dismissed being premature.
