Petitioner by way of instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeks direction to the official respondents for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion was issued on 22.10.2014 and Superintendent of Police, Karnal-respondent No.2 was directed to look into the matter.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Dayanand submits that matter was inquired into by the police. Initially, FIR No.411 dated 21.10.2014 for the offence under Sections 363, 366 and 120 B IPC was registered at Police Station Nising, District Karnal against the petitioner No.2. However, after recording the statements of parents of petitioner No.1, cancellation report has been prepared on 17.11.2014 and the same shall be presented to the Court of competent jurisdiction very shortly. He further

submits that in view of the said developments having been taken place, the present petition has rendered infructuous.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners also fairly states that in view of the statements made by learned State counsel, the instant petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above said respective stands taken by learned counsel for the parties, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
