RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further to ensure that they may not be harassed by respondent Nos. 5 and 6, as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4, in the shape of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Guhla, District Kaithal, has been filed, wherein it has been stated that a complaint dated 22.10.2014 was made by Bhupinder Singh-respondent No.6, alleging that on 21.10.2014, he along with his wife and mother had gone to village Kheri Gulam Ali for their personal work. His sister (petitioner No.1) was alone at their house. When they returned back, she was found missing and had been kidnapped by some unknown person. On the basis of this complaint, FIR No.158 dated 22.10.2014, under Section 365 IPC was registered. Thereafter,

the matter was enquired by ASI Rajbir Singh. Statements of complainant-respondent No.6 as well as Gurmit Kaur-respondent No.5 were recorded, wherein they have stated that petitioner No.1 was 28 years of age. She had solemnized marriage to petitioner No.2 on 21.10.2014 without their consent. Now they have no objection to the said marriage. Both the petitioners have also made their statements to the effect that now they do not need any police protection. Petitioner No.1 has also got recorded her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. to the effect that she had left her house at her own free will and she was not kidnapped by anybody.

In view of the reply filed, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
