Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 238 dated 17.08.2014, under Sections 420, 447, 448, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana City.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order 24.10.2014, a Co-ordinate Bench directed that in the event of arrest, petitioners would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with abovesaid case FIR.

On instructions from the Investigating Officer, learned State counsel informs that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for interrogation. Learned State counsel further informs

that report with regard to specimen signatures/thumb impressions of the petitioners sent for comparison has been received.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 24.10.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition disposed of accordingly.
