Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.65 dated 14.05.2014 registered under Sections 306, 511 IPC at Police Station Kotwali, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise.

Upon notice, respondent No.2 duly represented by counsel admits factum of compromise dated 21.05.2014. According to terms and conditions of the compromise, both the parties have amicably settled to part ways.

Resultantly, petition under Section 13-B of Hindu

Marriage Act was filed by the petitioner and respondent No.2, which has been allowed by Additional District Judge (Ad hoc), Fast Track Court, Amritsar vide judgment dated 03.01.2015 thereby dissolving the marriage by means of decree of divorce with mutual consent. Both the parties are ad idem that all the terms and conditions of compromise as well as decree stand complied with.

In view of the aforesaid, there is severance of joint matrimonial status of the parties. All penal proceedings have already been decided to be put at rest. Consequently, this FIR No.65 dated 14.05.2014 registered under Sections 306, 511 IPC at Police Station Kotwali, District Amritsar along with entire subsequent proceedings, if any, stand quashed.
