The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.131 dated 15.05.2013, under Sections 279, 304A of IPC and Sections 302, 148, 149 of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala during the pendency of the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balwan Singh submits that the trial is at advance stage as 12 prosecution witnesses have already been examined and two dates have been fixed for recording the statements of remaining PWs.

After hearing the submission made by learned counsel for the State and keeping in view the stage of the trial, no ground is made out to grant regular bail to the petitioner, at this stage. The Petition is dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial within some specified period.

The trial Court is directed to make all possible efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously.
