1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents especially respondent No.4 for conducting fair investigation in pursuance of FIR No.143 dated 15.04.2014 registered under Sections 394/34 IPC, at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat against respondent No.10.

Learned counsel has argued that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.4 but no action has been taken thereon and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.4 to look into the matter and decide his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.4-

Superintendent of Police, Panipat is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-3) and in case it is found that any action is required to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
