Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.113 dated 26.06.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 506, 452, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 30.10.2014:-

“Notice of motion, returnable for 12.01.2015.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer subject to the conditions laid down in section 438 sub section 2 clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Lal Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 30.10.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
