1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents especially respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel has argued that in this connection the petitioners have also moved a complaint and thereafter a representation dated 17.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.2 but no action has been taken thereon and at this stage they would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide their representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-3) and in case it is found that any action is required to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
