Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 398/401 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act in a case arising out of FIR No.90 dated 01.04.2014, registered at Police Station Urban Estate Rohtak, District Rohtak.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner Jasbir Singh along with other boys armed with knife, pipe and sticks were trying to rob the drivers of vehicle passing on the road at Gymkhana Club bye pass Rohtak. On apprehension, recovery of iron pipe was affected from the present petitioner and one knife from one Dinesh and a stick from Neeraj. After making the necessary recoveries, the petitioner was arrested on 01.04.2014.

The bail was declined by the lower appellate Court on the ground that after framing of the charges on 03.06.2014 no witnesses have been examined and if released on bail he will hamper the evidence.

Counsel for the State on instructions from Ram Sharan has informed this Court that FIR 462 under Sections 457, 380 IPC was registered against this petitioner on 09.12.2013 and he has been released on regular bail in this case.

During trial in the present case, out of nine official witnesses three have been examined. The petitioner is in custody for the last more than nine months and the trial is not likely to conclude and there are no private witnesses to be examined.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above facts, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Rohtak.
