This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.102, dated 29.08.2014 under Sections 325, 323, IPC, P.S. Islamabad, District Amritsar city, (Annexure P-1) and later on Section 326 IPC has been added vide Rapat No.28 dated 13.09.2014 (Annexure P-2)

There are serious allegations against the petitioner to the effect that in-laws of the son of the complainant entered into his house, thrown bricks and stones. There was a scuffle with complainant and her daughter as a result of

which the complainant has lost permanent vision of left eye. Prior to that the petitioner was granted interim bail under Sections 406, 498-A IPC vide order dated 03.11.2014.

Keeping in view the fact that serious allegations of offence of Section 326 IPC have been levelled and the complainant has lost permanent vision in one eye, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.
