Petitioner has presented this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondent authorities to take appropriate action against private respondents.

Under Section 482 Cr.P.C. scope of this court is limited. The petitioner has not made out case, therefore petition is not maintainable and it is dismissed. However in the interest of justice, 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent is directed to examine the representation dated 20.08.2015 and 05.10.2015 submitted by the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that despite making complaint against the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent no action has been taken by the police. It is alleged that 5<sup>th</sup> respondent Sh. Rakesh Kumar Sehgal s/o Charanjit Sehgal resident of Teacher Colony, Gali No. 2, Near Government School, Fazilka is interfering in the matter to not to entertain the petitioner's complaint before the police authorities. Therefore, it is directed that 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to examine the allegations stated in the representations and to take necessary action in the matter within period of 2 weeks from today.
