This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.658 dated 09.09.2015 registered under Sections 20, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the Court and move an application for regular bail and the Court may be directed to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender

before the Court on or before 17.11.2015 and move an application for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any within 4 days on merits.

Petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.
