HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents and not to interfere in their life at the instance of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 17.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that at this stage he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to look into the said

representation and to take appropriate remedial measures.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel today itself during the course of the day. At this stage, Mr. S.S. Goraya, Advocate also puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4.

Without commenting on the merits of the instant petition, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, is directed to look into the contents of the representation dated 17.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
