JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.71 dated 09.06.2014 for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Khalchian, District Amritsar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner without going into the merits of the allegations submits that the parties have entered an amicable settlement and based on the same CRM-M No.28149 of 2014 has been filed seeking quashing of the FIR itself. The same is stated to be listed for hearing on 27.11.2015.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from HC Kulwant Singh concedes regarding the pendency of the petition for quashing based on

compromise.

In view of the aforesaid developments, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of her arrest subject to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer. However, he shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.

It is however clarified that if there is any factual error the prosecution would be free to seek the recalling of the present order.
