ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 362 dated 04.08.2015, registered under Sections 12 of the Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 3(1) (xi) of the SC/ST Act, Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that no overt act had been attributed and the only allegations were that they were called by the petitioner.

On the last hearing, the State counsel was to inform whether the petitioner had been suspended or transferred from the school. Today the State counsel informs that an inquiry is going on but the petitioner has not been suspended nor has been transferred.

The petitioner cannot go back to the same school where the victims are students. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would take leave till he is transferred. It is also stated that the complainants have already made their statement before the Court and that stage is over.

In view of the undertaking given, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
