Report dated 10.3.2015 sent by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Ankush Sharma, Rajat Beniwal, Karan Rishi and Jagpreet Singh as well as of complainant Om Parkash it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the dispute between the parties has now been settled by way of compromise and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.188 dated 4.6.2013 under Sections 308, 325, 340 IPC Police Station, Sector 26, Chandigarh and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
