Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.143/15 dated 11.09.2015, under Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 26.10.2015:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the five alleged fake loan accounts were opened and operated before he joined as Inspector at Focal Point, Burj in AR Circle Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda on 8.3.2011. He further states that on an enquiry regarding the said accounts, marked to him, he had submitted enquiry report dated 4.5.2015 (Annexure P-4a to

4e). Whereupon, arbitration awards were made against the then Secretary Gurjant Singh and the Branch Managers Paramjit Singh, Hakam Singh and Sher Singh, who were held liable for making payment of the amounts against these accounts.

It is also stated that the entire case is based on documentary evidence, which is already in the possession of the Investigating Agency.

Notice of motion for 1.12.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting/investigating officer. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Jagir Singh has submitted petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 26.10.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
