This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. For quashing of FIR No. 115 dated 24.8.2012 under Sections 457, 380, 448, 511 IPC registered at Police Station Lambi District Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P1) on the basis of compromise (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malout has been received. The statements of the complainant and the accused have been recorded. It is reported that the parties have entered into compromise, which is voluntarily, without any pressure, coercion and with their free will. In this case, the allegations were of theft.

In view of the compromise between the parties, FIR No.

115 dated 24.8.2012 under Sections 457, 380, 448, 511 IPC

registered at Police Station Lambi District Sri Muktsar Sahib
(Annexure P1) along with consequential proceedings stands
quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
