The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.89, dated 27.7.2014, registered under Section 409 of the IPC, at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

The allegation against the petitioner was that he had embezzled the amount of ₹ 12 lacs from the Cooperative Society where he was working as a salesman.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody for almost four months; the investigation is over, and the trial is not likely to conclude in the near future.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Darshan

Singh, has not denied the factual assertion.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/CJM, Mansa.

Petition stands disposed of.
