Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 07.07.2015, under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 23.10.2015:-

"It is inter-alia argued that the parties have effected compromise on the basis of which similarly placed co-accused has been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting/investing officer. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as

and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

List on 17.12.2015 along with connected matters CRM-M- 35106 of 2015."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Gurmail Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 23.10.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
