SABINA, J

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 07.07.2015, under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 23.10.2015:-

"It is inter-alia argued that petitioner Manjit Kaur has not been named in the FIR and no specific role has been attributed to petitioner Labh Singh in the alleged suicide note by the deceased and that the parties have effected compromise on the basis of which similarly placed co-accused has been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2015.

Notice of motion.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting/investing officer. The petitioners shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

List on 17.12.2015 along with connected matters CRM-M- 35106 of 2015."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Gurmail Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 23.10.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
