**HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.74 dated 1.5.2014 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 22.9.2014 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 1.5.2015 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the trial Court was directed to submit its report about the genuineness of the

compromise as per the statements so recorded.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran and have got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded by the parties, the trial Court has submitted its report dated 9.9.2015 to the effect that the compromise entered between the parties is genuine one.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant admits the factum of compromise. The statement of complainant Sarabjit Singh reads as under:

*“Stated that I am the injured and complainant in present case and the present FIR No.74 dated 1.5.2014 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC Police Station Patti was registered against Gurmail Singh etc. We had effected the compromise with the accused of the present FIR with the intervention of respectable of village with my own free will without any coercion or pressure or consideration. I do not want to proceed against the accused in the present case. I have no objection if the proceedings against accused may be quashed. I want to live peacefully without any grudge against accused.”*

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and***

***another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and FIR No.74 dated 1.5.2014 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom is quashed, on the basis of compromise dated 22.9.2014 (Annexure P-2).
