Quashing of the FIR No.47 dated 27.06.2011 under Sections 279, 337, 427 of IPC (lateron added Section 338 IPC), registered at Police Station Sadar Sunam District Sangrur (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 15.09.2014 (Annexure P-2), is being sought.

FIR was registered on a statement made by Gurpreet Singh-respondent No.2/complainant alleging that the petitioner No.1-Ravi Kumar was negligent in driving his vehicle and an accident took place in which the complainant-Gurpreet Singh and Surinder Singh has suffered injuries. On this background, the FIR was lodged.

Now, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, during trial as per Annexure P-2.

Status report has been received from the Sub Divisional

Judicial Magistrate Sunam (Sangrur). Statement of the injured/eye witness Surinder Singh and the statement of the complainant have been recorded to the effect that a compromise has been affected without pressure, coercion or undue influence between the parties and the complainant does not want to proceed with the present FIR. SI Hardeep Singh has identified the complainant Gurpreet Singh and injured/eye witness Surinder Singh and the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.47 dated 27.06.2011 under Sections 279, 337, 427 of IPC (lateron added Section 338 IPC), registered at Police Station Sadar Sunam District Sangrur (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioner.
