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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Pursuant to the order dated 29.10.2014, passed by this Court, report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dera Bassi, received to the effect that the learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant Jasbir Singh, injured Sahib Singh and Bhupinder Singh. The learned Magistrate has also recorded the statement of the accused. It is reported that the parties have arrived at a compromise and the same is arrived at voluntarily.

In this case, the allegations were of criminal trespass, intimidation and causing simple injuries.

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Since the parties have amicably settled the dispute, therefore, FIR No. 91, dated 24.5.2013, registered under Sections 452/323/506/148/149 IPC at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar (Annexure-P-1) alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom stand quashed.
