Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks direction to the official respondents to conduct fair investigation by some independent agency in FIR No. 408 dated 31.8.2015 registered under Sections 307, 498-A, 120-B and 34 IPC at Police Station Sector-55, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to press this petition regarding transfer of investigation to some independent agency for the time being, reserving the right of the petitioner to do so at the appropriate stage, when necessity arises. He submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed, he finally approached the respondent authorities by way of self-contained representation dated 30.9.2015 (Annexure P-4), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case Commissioner of Police, Faridabad-respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide his representation, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad-respondent No.3, is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner raised in his representation dated 30.9.2015 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
