RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No. 223 dated 30.08.2015 under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that daughter of the complainant, namely, Baljit Kaur herself left the house of her parents with a view to join the company of the petitioner. At a later point of time, Rapat No.34 dated 02.09.2015 was recorded on the basis of statement made by Ms. Poonam Rani-sister of deceased Ms. Baljit Kaur against her own father i.e. the complainant in the present FIR and also against another lady who is a close relative of the deceased. He further submits that as a consequence, both the accused i.e. complainant in the present case and his co-accused have confessed causing of murder of Ms. Baljit Kaur. He prays for

allowing the present petition.

The above said statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner could not be denied by the learned State counsel and rightly so, it being a matter of record.

In view of the above and without making any further comments on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on bail pending trial, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

Disposed of, accordingly.
