MAHESH GROVER, J.

A perusal of the particulars furnished by the respondent would indicate that the petitioner is involved in numerous offences of the like nature. The allegations against the petitioner are that he was working in collusion with the mastermind who was running a immigration agency involved in duping persons on the pretext of sending them abroad. The cases against the petitioner being numerous and of the like nature would disentitle him to the concession of bail which is a discretionary relief to be afforded to persons who are not the habitual offenders. Noticing the conduct of the petitioner where he has indulged in this activity time and again, releasing him on bail at this juncture

would only prove counter productive for the gullible persons who
may be entrapped by him again.
