JASPAL SINGH, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.194, dated 19.08.2013, under Sections 308, 325, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) and affidavits (Annexures P-3 to P-5).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise has been effected between the complainant and accused voluntarily and

without any pressure. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

So, in view of above circumstances and in view of pronouncement reported as Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.194, dated 19.08.2013, under Sections 308, 325, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
