Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner Krishna Sen in case FIR No.338 dated 13.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad.

The allegations are that the accused-petitioner Krishna along with her co-accused husband Ajit Kumar Sen were operating a Chit Fund/Committee. They are alleged to have collected a huge amount running into crores over a period of last 10 years from 68 members.

Petitioner is concededly in custody since 15.08.2015 and after completion of investigation challan qua her has been presented.

It is also admitted that the co-accused husband Ajit Kumar Sen in his petition for grant of anticipatory bail has been granted interim protection on the plea that he would discharge the liabilities by selling his properties.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Tusha Kant is unable to refute the aforesaid factual situation.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period, petitioner being a lady and that aforesaid case is triable by a magistrate and conclusion of it is likely to take sometime, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner Krishna Sen is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.

Petition stands disposed of.
