Petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 217 dated 13.10.2014 registered under Sections 420/467/468/471/ and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana.

Perusal of FIR shows that Satyapal Nahar aged about 75 years owned a plot measuring 250 Sq. Yards, No. 123-I, Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, one Raj Virk prepared a false sale deed of the said plot and sold the same. During inquiry it

came out that Rajinder Singh @ Raja Kheri had approached the Halqa Patwari for getting the mutation sanctioned by producing forged affidavit of said Satyapal Nahar. Rajinder Singh @ Raja Kheri has taken the help of Sonu Sibia son of Jaswant Singh and Rajinder Singh @ Raja Kheri had tried to get the mutation sanctioned in the name of Satyapal Nahar by producing some imposter. One Balwinder put the signature as a witness on the agreement of full and final payment. In view of seriousness of the crime, the entire conspiracy in preparing the fake sale deed, getting the mutation sanctioned by producing an imposter and producing the forged affidavit are to be thoroughly investigated for which the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary.

Therefore, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.
