Charanjit Kaur and Harjit Kaur @ Surjit Kaur have applied for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 81 dated 30.09.2012 under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Qadian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

The petitioner No.1-Charanjit Kaur is stated to have been released on interim bail by the trial court in compliance to the order 31.10.2014 passed by this court. She was declared innocent and according to police investigation, she was on duty at the relevant date and time.

So, the order dated 31.10.2014 passed by this court is made absolute qua petitioner No.1-Charanjit Kaur.

So far as petitioner No.2-Harjit Kaur @ Surjit Kaur is concerned, the plea of alibi has been taken that she was present in some marriage. There are specific allegations in the FIR against petitioner No.2, who happened to be mother-in-law of deceased.

So, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail qua petitioner No.2-Harjit Kaur @ Surjit Kaur is made out.
